Scenario

- Alex has non-Hodgkin lymphoma and has completed chemotherapy. Standard care is chemotherapy and then radiation therapy. Alex wants to skip radiation, saying she's fine and doesn't need more treatment.
- Alex's parents say that Alex doesn't really know what she wants and report that Alex seems to be having more frequent "mood swings".
- At the suggestion of the oncology team, Alex's parents have requested a consultation with an adolescent psychiatrist, including a capacity assessment.


